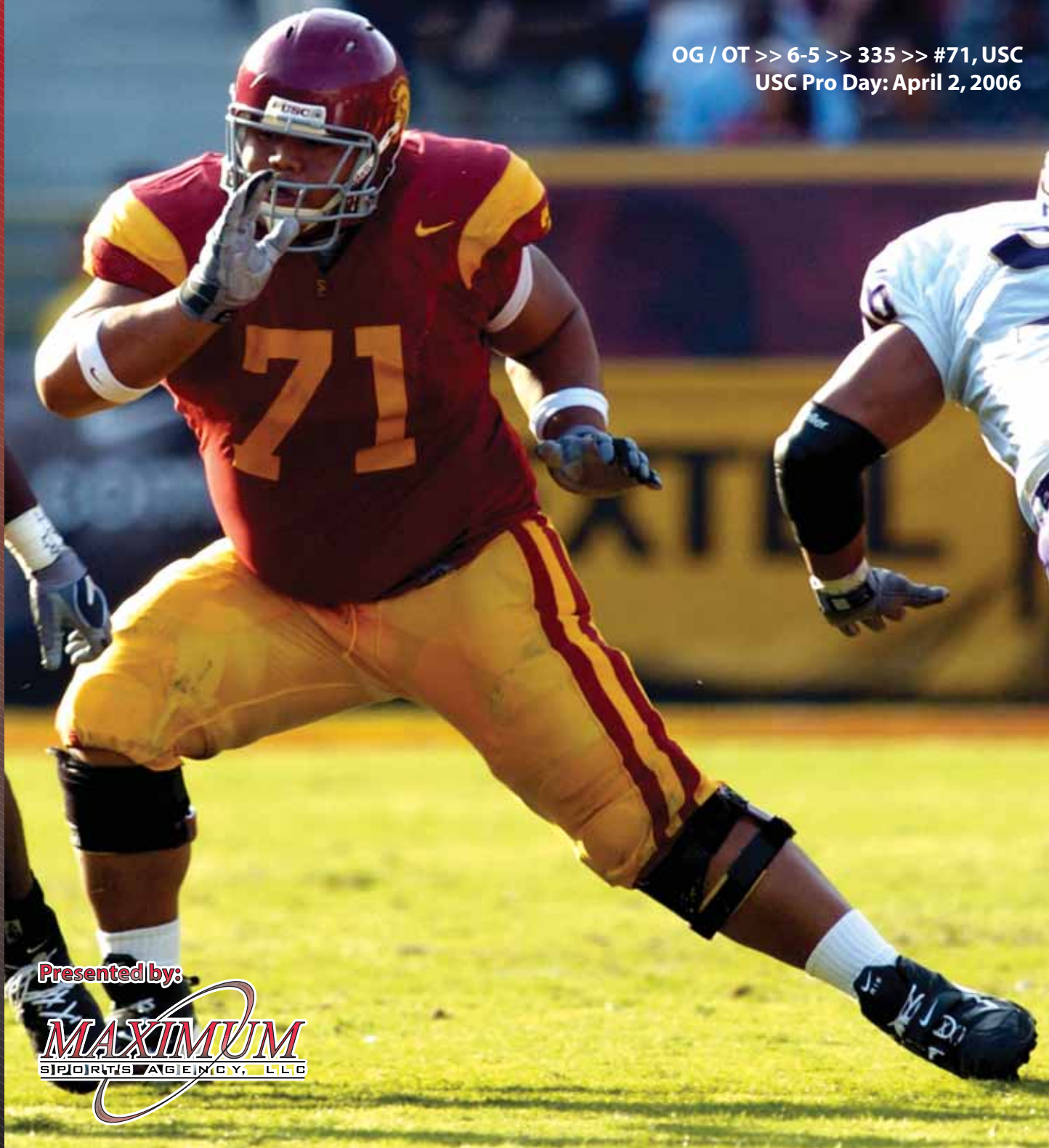

COLLEGE CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:

- 2005 1st Team All-American
 - ◆ Selected by: Football Coaches; Football Writers; ESPN.Com; SI.Com; CBS Sportsline.Com; Rivals.Com; Sporting News; The Sports Xchange
- 2005-06 Rivals.com All-Bowl Team - (Held fellow All-American, DT Rodrigue Wright, to no sacks and no tackles in the 2006 Rose Bowl.)
- Most celebrated member of USC's offensive line, which Oregon Head Coach Mike Bellotti called "one of the greatest in college football history."
- **2005 Season**
 - ◆ Showed great versatility in moving inside to left guard where he immediately anchored arguably the best offensive line in college football.
 - ◆ Recipient of multiple USC Team Awards, which included: "Offensive Lineman of the Year;" "Lifter of the Year;" and "Co-Inspirational Player of the Year."
 - ◆ 1st Team All-Pac-10.
 - ◆ Selected the top offensive lineman in the Pac-10 by College Football News
- **2004 Season**
 - ◆ Came to USC in the Summer of 2004 as a heralded junior college transfer.
 - ◆ Immediately replaced Winston Justice, who was suspended for the year, at right offensive tackle.
 - ◆ Started all 13 games at right tackle and played a large role in helping USC win a National Championship.
 - ◆ Showed the ability to play outside with great mobility for his size.
- **2002 Season** (Mesa Community College) **and 2003 Season** (Snow Junior College, Ephraim, Utah)
 - ◆ Named to the 2003 J.C. Grid-Wire All-American first team, National Junior College Athletic Association All-American first team, Super Prep JUCO 100 and All-Western States Football League first team as a sophomore offensive lineman.
 - ◆ Helped Snow finish at 9-1 and tie for fourth in the final NJCAA poll.

- ◆ "He's a tremendous person and a tremendous football player. I've seen some really good guys, but he's one of the most genuine I've ever been around. I think he could start for about 20 pro teams right now." Offensive Line Coach Pat Ruel
- ◆ "It's exciting to see a guy get a chance to come out of junior college and in two years time start in every game for us and take it all the way to All-American recognition." Head Coach Pete Carroll

PREP: As a senior two-way lineman at Mesa (Ariz.) High in 2001, he was a Super Prep All-Farwest, Prep Star All-West, Long Beach Press-Telegram Best of the Rest, All-State, All-Region and All-Conference selection. As a junior in 2000, he made All-State, All-Region and All-Conference.

PERSONAL: Married to Puanani in the summer of 2004. He and his wife are raising their son, Inoke Liuaki Moeltau ("Return a champion"), who was born the day after USC's win in the 2005 Orange Bowl. Since he survived an auto accident when he was 6 years old that killed his sister and disabled his father he, along with his siblings, has helped take care of his family (i.e pay bills). He can dunk a basketball. His nickname is "Deuce". He was born in Ha'api, Tonga.
